Republic Services - Mark Starr

Mr. Starr stated that Kera came to the Republic Services office regarding a Village Clean Up. He said first we would need to schedule the day and determine if we are bringing trucks for pick up or dumpsters. If bringing dumpsters, we would identify where the dumpsters go, what day, and how many residents would participate. Volunteers might be needed. There should be a place to drive thru, and law enforcement would check IDs. It's important to get the dates on the calendar. There are restrictions on what can be dumped, such as anything with a cord, batteries, paint, appliances. They have a scrap container where the village would get a rebate. He will email his recommendations and costs.
